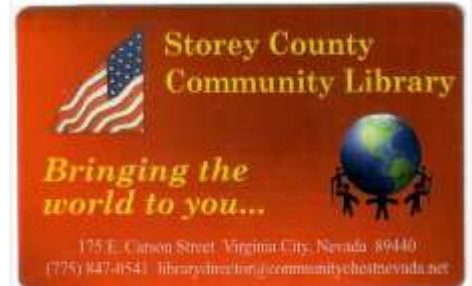
Our Library Suggestions
